

16. How do providers or employers get involved in learnerships?

If training providers or workplaces/ employers want to be involved in a learnership, they can first check and see if there are already any relevant learnerships registered with the Department of Labour. A list is available at every labour centre or from the Department of Labour (www.labour.gov.za). Remember that you can choose any learnership no matter which SETA developed and registered it. With an already registered learnership, you will then contact the relevant SETA or the Department of Labour, depending on your target audience and aims. If there is no registered learnership, you will need to see if a relevant qualification is registered. Again, you will then follow through with the relevant SETA. Another common route is for providers to respond to requests for Expressions of Interest by SETAs for particular projects.
