

17. How do learners get involved in learnerships?

An employer who has decided to offer a learnership will usually call for candidates from its workplace/s who meet the criteria, or select particular target groups of learners. Employees interested in learnerships should contact their human resource departments or skills development facilitators for information. Providers or workplaces may also choose to target a learnership at unemployed workers. Usually in this case the Department of Labour will advertise or recruit potential learners, possibly in partnership with the relevant SETA. Unemployed learners should go to their nearest labour centre to get information on possible learnerships.
